ABOUT Ph.D. PROGRAMME

The Ph.D. Programmes (Full Time / Part Time) of Glocal University aims at global training and developing researchers and teachers who would be at the forefront in creating and disseminating knowledge. The broad objectives of the Ph.D. programs are to keep pace with the expanding frontiers of knowledge and to provide research and innovation-based solutions relevant to the present social and economic purposes and problems for better livelihood of humankind. The University follows all rules, regulations as laid by the regulating bodies for research work.

- Admissions to Ph.D. programs at Glocal University campuses are conducted twice a year, for January and July sessions.
- A Ph.D. program is offered in two modes- Full time and Part time. A Full-time Ph.D. scholar shall mean a candidate devoting full time for completing the requirements of the program and a part- time Ph.D. scholar shall mean a candidate who is devoting a part of his time towards the pursuit of the program while discharging his official / employment obligations.
- Ph.D. full time is for minimum 3 years and Ph.D. part time for minimum 4 years. Maximum duration in case of both the modes is 6 years. • Coursework, participation in various interactions, submission of progress reports through presentations etc. on regular basis is mandatory during the program.
- The University encourages interdisciplinary research and exchange of ideas and knowledge in various related fields.
- The main Guide for the scholar during the Ph.D. program will be from Glocal University, appointed as per the research topic and Guide availability.
- Part time Candidates should ensure that, there will be a requirement to have a Co-guide. External Co-Guide will however be appointed only after his/her profile is approved by the university authorities.
- The University is being associated with various research laboratories of Govt./Semi-Govt. and industries in various disciplines & various Libraries and E — resources.
