Glocal University offers a range of vocational training and executive education programs that are open to the general public, aimed at enhancing skills and career development:





• Industry-Specific Training: We collaborate with local businesses and organizations to offer specialized training programs that address specific industry needs, helping workers advance in their careers.






### 4.3.4:



- **Skill-Based Programs:** Host workshops on essential skills like digital literacy, critical thinking, and entrepreneurship.


### 2. Research and Innovation
