

## **GLOCAL UNIVERSITY, SAHARANPUR**

### **PH.D. Admission Policy**

#### **Overview**

The programme offers highly qualified and intellectually outstanding students an opportunity to pursue their research work at an advanced level in a high challenging but academically conducive environment. In pursuance of the *UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil/Ph.D. degree) Regulation 2009/2016*), the Ph.D., programme of the Glocal University, is intended for those who wish to pursue research work after completing their postgraduate degrees in technology, science, management, law etc. and to develop higher research aptitude, and considering an academic career. With a view to encouraging interdisciplinary studies the Glocal University, Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh encourages candidates to register for interdisciplinary Ph.D. Work in various schools/departments of the Glocal University.

#### **Procedure for admission:**

Glocal University will admit Ph.D. students through an Entrance Test. Those students who qualify UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/SLET/GATE/teacher fellowship holder or have passed M.Phil programme shall be exempted from appearing in the written test but compulsory to appear before committee/Admission Counselling for the admission.



**Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. programme:**

Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
